

2. God's rescue <u>ACCOMPLISHED</u> what we so desperately needed.

Colossians 1:13-14

<u>**RESCUE:**</u> 'to draw out... to one's self' – i.e. to rescue for oneself (to oneself). [It] implies removing someone in the *midst* (presence) of danger or oppression.

- Though we celebrate how His earthly life began in a manger, we always want to keep front and center the King that Jesus became and the <u>ATONEMENT</u> He accomplished on our behalf.
