The word "prodigal" means "<u>RECKLESSLY</u> extravagant, having spent everything"

2. Our "finding Father" seeks us when we're <u>LOST</u> and celebrates when we're FOUND.

Luke 15:25-32



Note that whether the younger brother was miles away or older brother was just out in the field, both of them were not "<u>WITH HIM</u>" and the father actively went out to meet them both where they were.

You cannot discount prodigals who are returning to the Father because they're not just "his kids" but your <u>BROTHER</u> or <u>SISTER</u> as well.
