## How the world's desires oppose God and your love for Him:

- The lust of the flesh inappropriate affections for things that appeal to pleasures that you sense – things you want to <u>FEEL!</u>
- The lust of the eyes inappropriate affections for things that capture your imagination and attention – things you want to POSSESS!
- The pride of life inappropriate affections for selfreliance and esteem found in your accomplishments or abilities – things that make you think you're AMAZING!

Specifically, the "lust of the eyes" shifts your <u>AFFECTIONS</u> from recognizing that it's all God's and He's entrusted you with some of His stuff to manage according to His priorities.
