Luke 24:25-27; Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7




Old Testament References to a Messiah Who Would Suffer:

- Psalm 22 foretold that Messiah would be forsaken, pierced and vindicated.
- Isaiah 52 & 53 foretold that Messiah would be a suffering servant.
- Psalm 118 foretold that Messiah would be the rejected cornerstone.
- Genesis 22 foretold that Messiah would be a willing sacrifice.
- Psalm 69 foretold that Messiah would be a righteous sufferer.
- Jeremiah 31 foretold that Messiah would be the object of a murderous plot.
- Psalm 16 foretold that Messiah would be resurrected.

- Have you put <u>expectations</u> upon Jesus that He never said He would do for you?
- Have you claimed <u>promises</u> from Jesus that He never promised you?
- Have you put Jesus on a <u>timetable</u> to provide for you that He's never agreed to?
