

1. Faith in God doesn't require <u>CLARITY</u> or <u>AGREEMENT</u> with His ways.

Habakkuk 1:1–4

- Habakkuk reminds us that while God may seem silent and <u>UNINVOLVED</u> in our world, He always has a plan to deal with evil and always works out <u>JUSTICE</u>... eventually.

2. Faith in God is required to be "<u>RIGHT</u>" with Him.

3. Faith in God is demonstrated <u>MOST</u> when our circumstances seem blessed the <u>LEAST</u>.
