- **3.** Today we learned that God gives us a new start. How does God do that? (When we tell Him we are sorry and ask Him to help us be better, God forgives us and helps us.)
- 4. Who can you tell that God knows everything that happens? (Answers will vary.)
- 5. Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me. Ready? Redo! (Redo!) God Forgives Me and You! (God Forgives Me and You!)

### STORY SCRIPT

# **Leading into Story/Worship**

We are going to have so much fun today! Today's Big Deal is, "Redo! God Forgives Me and You!" A Big Deal is a special truth we can learn about God. Let's say it together. I'll say it first, and you can say it after me. Redo! (Redo!) God Forgives Me and You! (God Forgives Me and You!) When God forgives us, He gives us a new start. Let's say, "God gives me a new start," together. Ready? "God gives me a new start." Wow! That was super!

### **After the Bible Story Video**

In today's Bible story, Jesus invited a tax collector named Matthew to follow Him. Jesus gave Matthew a new start. He forgave Matthew for his sins, the wrong choices he had made.

God made a perfect world and created people to live in it and be His friends. Can you make a big circle above your head with me? (Model drawing a circle above your head and invite preschoolers to do the same.)

Great job! God loved the world He made, but Adam and Eve, the first people, disobeyed God's one rule, bringing sin into the world. Can you make an X with me? (Take your arms and model the X.) Sin makes the world sad and broken, and it separates people from God. Even today, we all sin by doing wrong things, and that's why we need Jesus.

God loves us and sent His Son, Jesus, to help fix our broken friendship with Him. Jesus is our King who wants to take away our sin and give us a new start. Can you take a pretend crown and place it out in front of you like you are putting it on someone's head? (Demonstrate this for preschoolers and have them do this with you.)

When we believe in Jesus and follow Him, God forgives us, and we can have a friend-ship with Him again. One day, everyone who believes in Jesus will live forever with Him in heaven.

Let's pray and talk to God. We can thank Him for sending Jesus. When we ask Jesus to forgive us, He does! Let's close our eyes as we pray. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1. God, thank You for forgiving us. Thank You that Jesus came so we can be forgiven and have a friendship with You. Thank You for giving us a new start. Amen.

- 5. Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me. Ready? Redo! (Redo!) God Forgives Me and You! (God Forgives Me and You!)

# **STORY SCRIPT**

# **Leading into Story/Worship**

Today we are learning that God forgives us. That makes me think about our Big Deal. Our Big Deal teaches something important and true about God. Today's Big Deal is, "Redo! God Forgives Me and You!" Let's practice saying it together. I'll say it first, and you can say it after me. Redo! (Redo!) God Forgives Me and You! (God Forgives Me and You!) When God forgives us, it means that He lets go of our wrong choices. Today we are going to learn that God forgives us when we ask Him. God can change our hearts to know and love Him.

### **After the Bible Story Video**

Thank you, Super Crew! I knew you all would be able to help.

(To preschoolers) Wow! In today's Bible story, we learned that God had a special message for His people. God sent His message to a prophet named Jeremiah. God's message was that He is the only One who has the power to change people's hearts. When we talk about God changing our hearts, we mean that God helps us want to make right choices. God helps us love and care about Him and other people. God said He would forgive the people's wrong choices and change their hearts to know and love Him. We all sin, which means we make wrong choices, and we need God to forgive us and help us. When we ask God to forgive us, He does! He changes our hearts to know and love Him too!

Today's Super Clue is new batteries. When you put new batteries in a toy, the toy works like new again. When God forgives us, He changes our hearts and makes us new. Only God can change our hearts to know and love Him. Hearing the word forgive reminds me of our Big Deal, "Redo! God Forgives Me and You!"

Let's pray and talk to God. We can thank Him for sending Jesus. Let's close our eyes as we pray. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, You are so powerful and forgiving. We are thankful You forgive us when we ask and change our hearts to know and love You. Thank You for sending Jesus. Amen.

# **STORY SCRIPT**

# **Leading into Story/Worship**

When we have a redo, it means we get another chance to do something. When we ask God for a redo, we ask Him to forgive us. That is a big deal! Today we have a special Big Deal that helps us learn something super important about God. Today's Big Deal is, "Redo! God Forgives Me and You!" Let's say our Big Deal together. I'll say it first and show you the motions, and then you say it after me. Redo! (Redo!) God Forgives Me and You! (God Forgives Me and You!) Wonderful! When we ask God to forgive us, He forgives our wrong choices and gives us a new hope. Let's say, "God gives me a new hope," together. Ready? "God gives me a new hope." Super job!

### **After the Bible Story Video**

In today's Bible story, God's people were hurting and suffering because of their wrong choices, but when they turned away from their wrong choices and asked God to forgive them, He did. God gave them a new hope in Him. Hope is waiting and trusting that something good is coming. Like a U-turn sign shows us when to turn around and go a different way, God's people did a U-turn when they turned away from their wrong choices. God forgave them, and they got a chance to have a redo and make right choices. That is a big deal! Let's say our Big Deal together. "Redo! God Forgives Me and You!" God offers to give us a redo too. We all sin, which means we make wrong choices, and we need God to forgive us and help us. The good news is God sent Jesus so we can be forgiven and have a friendship with Him. When we ask God to forgive us, He does, and He gives us a new hope in Him. This new hope helps us turn from our wrong choices and follow Him.

Let's pray and talk to God. We can thank Him for sending Jesus. When we ask Jesus to forgive us, He does! Let's close our eyes as we pray. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You for sending Jesus to forgive us. Thank You for giving us the chance to turn from our wrong choices and turn to go a different way. Help us follow You. Amen.
