WELCOME STATIONS

2s & 3s

- 1. Set out **Magna Blocks and Magnet People**. Encourage the children to build with them.
- 2. Set out **Mr Potato Heads or Food Cutting Items** and encourage kids to play with them.
- 3. Set out the **Playdough** Encourage the kids to explore it.

PreK

- 1. Set out **Shaving Cream and Trays.** Encourage them to "draw" in the shaving cream. Use smocks as needed.

- 3. How does God care for us today? (God knows what we think. When we think wrong thoughts, we can pause and ask God for help. We can remember that God loves us and cares for us no matter what. God can help take away our wrong thoughts.)

Leading into Story/Worship

Hi, friends! I love it when we get to be at church together—it is so much fun! I've been thinking all week about what we will be learning about today. Let's start by learning our Big Deal. A Big Deal is an important truth that teaches us something about God. Today's Big Deal is, "Press Pause! God Cares When I Hurt!" Do you know what pause means? (Allow responses.) Pause means to stop and take a minute to breathe or think. Let's say our Big Deal together. I'll say it first, and you can say it after me. Press Pause! (Press Pause!) God Cares When I Hurt! (God Cares When I Hurt!) Great job!

Today we will be learning about how God knows our thoughts, the things we think. God cares for us when we are happy and when we are sad, and He knows our happy thoughts and our sad thoughts. Sometimes we may even think wrong thoughts about doing things that are unkind, and God knows those too. Whenever we have wrong thoughts or are tempted, which means we have the chance to make a wrong choice, we can pause, stop what we are doing, and ask God for help.

After the Bible Story Video

In our Bible story today, God knew what Moses was thinking, that he was worried and did not believe in God's plan or power. God was not happy with Moses' wrong thoughts, but still, God promised to be with Moses and help him. God knows what we think, too, even our wrong thoughts, like when we doubt that God's plan is good. Let's say, "God knows what I think," together. Ready? "God knows what I think."

Let's pray and thank God for always caring for us. When we pray, we are talking and listening to God.

God, thank You for loving and caring for us, even when we think wrong thoughts. Help us remember that we can always press pause and ask You for help. You are with us every day. Amen.

Read - John 20:24-29

Reflect - How can you turn to Jesus when your heart is struggling to believe?

- A. When I am overwhelmed by my circumstances, I can ask Jesus to help me trust and believe in His plan.
- B. When I am hurt or disappointed, I can ask Jesus to help me trust and believe in His purpose.
- C. When I feel helpless or hopeless, I can ask Jesus to help me trust and believe in His power.

SMALL TALK QUESTIONS

- 1. Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (a feelings chart)
- 2. What does a feelings chart help us remember? (A feelings chart helps you name what you are feeling. God cares when we hurt, and He knows our heart and how we are feeling.)
- **3. From our Bible story today, what was Thomas feeling in his heart?** (Thomas was doubting that Jesus was alive.)
- 4. God knows your heart. What does it mean that God knows your heart? (God knows what is going on inside us, like when we doubt or even when we make wrong choices, but He still loves us and wants us to believe and follow Him.)
- 5. Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me. Press Pause! (Press Pause!) God Cares When I Hurt! (God Cares When I Hurt!)

CONNECTION ACTIVITIES

2s & 3s

- 1. GAME: Heart Toss: Preschoolers will toss beanbags onto hearts to remember that "God Knows My Heart".
- 2. CRAFT: Feelings Chart: Preschoolers will glue their emotions face onto the corresponding face. Help the children name each feeling. Have them show you their happy face, sad face, etc.

- 1. GAME: Heart Relay: Preschoolers will play a game where they will put together paper hearts to remember that "God Knows My Heart".
- 2. CRAFT: Finish the Face: Preschoolers will finish the emotions on the faces on their papers. Help the children name each feeling. Have them show you their happy face, sad face, etc.



Leading into Story/Worship

Welcome, friends! Before we get started, let's see if we can use our hands to make shapes. Wiggle your fingers to get them ready. Can you make a circle with your hands? (Demonstrate, then allow preschoolers to try.) Great job! Can you make a triangle? (Demonstrate, then allow preschoolers to try.) Wow! This one is tricky. Can you make a heart with your hands? (Demonstrate, then allow preschoolers to try.) I love all of your heart shapes! Now let's all clap our hands one time. Ready? Clap! (Allow responses.) Now let's clap three times. Ready? Clap three times! (Allow responses.) Now, when I say, "Go," you will clap until I press pause. When I say, "Pause," we will all stop clapping at the same time. Ready? 3-2-1 Go! Clap until I press pause. (Allow responses.) Pause! Great! Whenever we need to stop what we are doing or take a break, we can press pause and stop, just like we did with our clapping.

After the Bible Story Video

Thanks, Super Crew!

(To preschoolers) I knew they could help us connect our Super Clue to the Big Deal. In our Bible story, do you remember how Thomas was feeling a little unsure? His heart was wondering if the man in front of him was actually Jesus, the Son of God. God knew that Thomas was doubting, and God knew what was inside Thomas' heart. Jesus was so kind to show Thomas His hands to prove that He truly was the Son of God. Just like God knew Thomas' heart, He knows our hearts too. He knows when we are sad and when we are happy. Let's say, "God knows my heart," together. Ready? "God knows my heart."

Let's pray together. When we pray, we are talking and listening to God. We can thank God for knowing our hearts.

God, thank You so much for knowing our hearts and loving us. Thank You for helping us when we ask. We love You! Amen.

- 2. What does a light switch help us remember? (A light switch helps us turn on a light, and the light helps us see the actions of everyone in the room. God sees all of our actions—even our wrong choices.)
- **3. Who did God send to David to tell him that he had made a wrong choice?** (The prophet, Nathan)
- 4. What can we do when we know that our actions are wrong? (Press pause and ask God for forgiveness.)
- 5. Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me. Press Pause! (Press Pause!) God Cares When I Hurt! (God Cares When I Hurt!)

Leading into Story/Worship

Welcome, friends! I am so excited to be here with all of you. Today we get to learn about something super important. We are learning how God knows our actions. What are actions? (Allow responses.) Actions are the things we do. Actions can be something like this (wave your arms), or actions can be something like this (high-five a preschooler). God knows our actions because He is God, and He knows everything. Today we are going to learn about how God cares when we hurt. This could be physical hurt, like falling down, or it could be hurt we feel inside, like hurt feelings or feeling sad. When we make a mistake with our actions, God wants us to stop whatever we are doing and ask for help because He cares for us and is always ready to help us obey. That reminds me of our Big Deal. A Big Deal is an important truth we learn about God. Today's Big Deal is, "Press Pause! God Cares When I Hurt!" Let's say it together. I'll say it first, and you can say it after me. Press Pause! (Press Pause!) God Cares When I Hurt! (God Cares When I Hurt!) Super!

After the Bible Story Video

Bye, Super Crew! See you next time!

(To preschoolers) In our Bible story, David made a wrong choice, and Nathan helped David see that he was making a wrong choice. David was sorry for his wrong choices and wrote a prayer asking God to forgive him. God knew David's actions and knew he made a wrong choice.

God knows our actions too. God knows when we make wrong choices, and He is ready to forgive us. When we make a wrong choice, we can press pause, stop what we are doing, and ask God to forgive us. And He always does!

Let's pray and thank God for knowing our actions and forgiving us when we ask.

God, thank You so much for always being ready to forgive us when we make a wrong choice. Help us make right choices and obey You. Amen.

Leading into Story/Worship

Today we are going to be learning about something so special. We are learning about how God cares for us when we hurt. That reminds me of our Big Deal. A Big Deal is something important we can learn about God. Today's Big Deal is, "Press Pause! God Cares When I Hurt!" Let's practice saying our Big Deal together. I'll say it first, and you can say it after me. Press Pause! (Press Pause!) God Cares When I Hurt! (God Cares When I Hurt!) Good job! God cares when our hearts are sad and when our hearts are happy. When we are we are sad, mad, scared, or upset, we can press pause and remember that God cares when we hurt. When we press pause that means we stop or take a break. God also cares when we need something. Today we are learning that God knows what we need. Let's say, "God knows my need," together. Ready? "God knows my need." Wow! Isn't that super?

After the Bible Story Video

In our Bible story, we learned that instead of needing more things, what we need most is a friendship with God. A rich ruler asked Jesus how he could have life forever with God. Jesus knew what he really needed. He needed forgiveness and a friendship with God. God knows what we need most too. He knows that we are all hurt by sin and helps us with our real need—forgiveness and a friendship with Him.

Today's Super Clue is a water bottle. A water bottle reminds us that we need water for our bodies to be healthy. Jesus teaches us that we need friendship with God so we can have life forever with Him. God knows our need, and He knows what we need most of all–forgiveness and a friendship with Him. God knows my need. Let's say that together. Ready? "God knows my need." Great job! God cares for us and knows what we need most. Let's say our Big Deal together. I'll say it first, and you say it after me. Ready? Press Pause! (Press Pause!) God Cares When I Hurt! (God Cares When I Hurt!)

Let's pray and thank God for knowing all of our needs. When we pray, we are talking and listening to God.
