SMALL TALK QUESTIONS

- 1. Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (a box of crayons)
- 2. What does a box of crayons help us remember? (Crayons help us remember that God made us original. Remember, original means one-of-a-kind and not like anyone else. We each have different gifts and abilities.)
- 3. In today's Bible story, we learned about a man named Paul. What did Paul encourage Christians in the church at Rome to do with their special gifts and talents? (Paul encouraged Christians to use their special gifts and talents to tell others about Jesus.)
- 4. Today we learned that God made you original. What is one way that God makes us original and special? (He gives us special gifts that only we can use to tell others about Jesus.)
- 5. Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me. Ready? Oh Wow! (Oh Wow!) God Made Me Special! (God Made Me Special!)

CONNECTION ACTIVITIES

- 2. CRAFT: God Made me Special Hand Flower Pot: Preschoolers will glue their handprint and flowerpot onto a piece of construction paper. Then you will encourage them to put flower stickers on their handprint fingertips. Remind them that God made them special; one of a kind.

- GAME: Wrap the Gift Relay: Preschoolers will form two teams and race to see who can wrap the gift first.
- 2. CRAFT: God Made Me Special Page: Help each child to write their name, color the person to look like them and answer the questions on the paper. Encourage them to draw pictures in the boxes. Ask them to tell you about their picture and write the words for the child. Remind them that God made them special; one of a kind.

STORY SCRIPT

Leading into Story/Worship

(God Made Me Special!) You all are super special! We can learn that God made us original by looking in the Bible. The Bible is God's Book. The Bible is true, and it's for you! We will learn a verse from the Bible that helps us understand more about how God made us original. Let's watch a video to learn our Theme verse.

After the Bible Story Video

Thanks for your help today, Super Crew! See you next time!

Oh wow! God made you original and special. We are all made special by God. Thanks for coming today! I've enjoyed seeing each of your smiling faces.

Let's pray and ask God to help us remember that He made us special. When we pray, we talk and listen to God. Let's close our eyes and make our bodies very still to focus on talking to God. Let's pray in 3-2-1.

STORY SCRIPT

Leading into Story/Worship

Welcome, everyone! I am so glad you are here today. If you are glad to be here, I want you to show me your biggest smile. Ready? Let me see those smiles! (Pause and wait for preschoolers to respond.) It looks like you are happy to be here, just like I am! Our Theme for this month is Oh Wow! When I think about things that make me say, "Oh wow!" I think about art. When we are working on our own piece of artwork, we want it to be special and one of a kind. Today's Big Deal reminds us that we are one of a kind to God. Our Big Deal is, "Oh Wow! God Made Me Special!" I want you to say it with me. I'll say it first, and then you say it after me. Oh Wow! (Oh Wow!) God Made Me Special! (God Made Me Special!) You are awesome! Today we are learning that God made me on purpose. That means God has a special plan for each of us. Isn't that super?

After the Bible Story Video

Thanks, Super Crew!

(To preschoolers) In today's Bible story, God had a special plan for Jeremiah before he was born. God wanted Jeremiah to give God's people important messages. Jeremiah was special to God, and God had a plan for his life. You are special to God too. He has a plan for your life.

Our Super Clue today is play dough. When we open a container of play dough, we already have something in mind that we want to create or make. God made each of us special. Today we are learning that God made me on purpose. Let's say that together. "God made me on purpose."

Let's take a moment to stop and talk to God by praying. Praying means talking and listening to God. Let's be still and pray in 3-2-1.

God, we are so thankful You made each of us. Thank You for the plans and purposes You have for each preschooler here. Help us remember that You made us on purpose, and You have special plans for us. Help us love You more this week and show Your love to others. In Jesus' name, Amen.

STORY SCRIPT

Leading into Story/Worship

Hello, everyone! I am so glad you are here today! Can you give me a wave and a hello? I'll go first. (Wave to the group and say hello. Lead preschoolers to wave and say hello.) Awesome! Let's stand up and sing together. Singing is one of my favorite parts of the day. When we are singing our songs, we aren't just singing for fun; we are also singing to God. We are celebrating God when we sing songs to Him.

After the Bible Story Video

Thanks, Super Crew!

(To preschoolers) In our Bible story today, we learned about how God provided skilled and talented workers to build His tabernacle. A tabernacle is a special place to praise and worship God. The skilled workers obeyed God and used their talents to make the tabernacle and bring praise to God. Remember, talented means that God made each one of us really good at different things. God made you special. That reminds me of our Big Deal. Let's say it together. "Oh Wow! God Made Me Special!"

Today's Super Clue is instruments. It takes talent and skill to play an instrument. God gives us talents and skills to do amazing things. Some of us can draw, some of us can play instruments, some of us can sing, some of us can make people laugh, and so much more.

Let's pray and thank God for giving us special talents that we can use to celebrate and praise Him. When we pray, we talk and listen to God. Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, we are so thankful for You. Thank You for making each of us special with talents that we can use to celebrate and praise You. We love You. In Jesus' name, amen.

I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

After the Bible Story Video

Thanks, Super Crew!

I love today's Bible story about the lost sheep. The shepherd really loved all of his sheep. When one went missing, he left all the others to go find it. That sheep was really valuable to the shepherd. We are valuable to God, and He made each one of us special. God loves us and says we are valuable and important to Him.

Does anyone remember what our Super Clue is today? (A game piece.) Yes! It is a game piece. Each game piece is valuable to its game, and we are valuable and special to God.

That reminds me of our Big Deal, "Oh Wow! God Made Me Special!" Let's say that together. I'll say it first, and you say if after me. Ready? Oh Wow! (Oh Wow!) God Made Me Special! (God Made Me Special!) Great job!

Let's pray and thank God for making us special and valuable. When we talk and listen to God, this is called prayer. God hears all of our prayers! Let's be still and pray to God.

God, thank You that You love us so much. Thank You that we are valuable to You. Thank You for making us special. In Jesus' name, amen.

Let's pray and talk to God. We can thank Him that He made us and that we matter to Him. Let's close our eyes so we aren't distracted by others around us. Let's pray in 3-2-1.
